Each year the Orvis Fly Program receives hundreds of submissions of new and innovative fly patterns from fly tiers around the world. From these we choose those patterns that best represent the most inventive and effective flies being tied today. Flies proven to work and tied by some of the most knowledgeable tiers, fly fishers and guides. These flies are the very foundation of the Orvis Fly Program. When a pattern is selected, the tier receives a royalty for each fly sold.

David Hise is a tier who represents all those tiers who make the program the best contract tier program there out there.

David has been tying since he was a young teenager. He worked as a guide in Montana and currently resides and guides for steelhead and brown trout in Michigan.



A short time ago, David submitted a couple dozen patterns to the Orvis Fly Program. His Hise's Hex and Comet Pom particularly impressed us. They not only proved effective, but had the mark of a master tyer and a fisherman who knows the species he's after. His patterns are now used by fly fishers on waters around the world. As David puts it, "I keep tying, trying to create and perfect patterns useful to me and other fly fishers. Since I use the patterns myself, I make ongoing alterations to change functionality and effectiveness."

### A. FLY-TYING WORK CENTER

Organize your work surface and make your tying time more productive. Stained red oak base and arms with a laminate, 12" x 15" work surface that makes spotting materials and cleaning easier. Ten holes on the arm for tools. Cement jar hole and seven pegs for thread, wire, etc. C-clamp adjusts for left- or right-hand tiers. Card holder for tying recipes. Magnetic strip for flies and hooks. Rubber feet protect work surfaces. 12" x 21".

### B. CAHILL FLY-TYING BENCH

Organize your tying space without really trying. This beautiful rock maple bench with brass drawer handle offers an organized work area that will increase your productivity by keeping all materials close at hand. Bench top slides open to reveal divided storage area beneath. Work area includes a hook magnet, dish, and holders for tools and bottles. Brass screws and hardware. 17" x 11½" x 7½".
